#### INTRODUCTION

Camouflage patterns are quickly evolving. This free compilation is designed to help you search for the most effective camouflage pattern for your camouflage and concealment needs. All the following camo pattern swatches are presented without bias, criticism, or endorsement. I have not included any of the non-typical/non-subdued base color camouflage patterns (i.e. pink or purple) or patterns that contain overt novelty shapes that do not serve a true camouflage and concealment purpose. The blaze orange camouflage patterns are the exception, as they are required in most states for hunting many big game species. Also included are a few nautical blue patterns, even though their use would be very limited.


