ABOUT THE SITE

LyondellBasell's Botlek site was built in 1972. The site is located in the industrial complex at Seinehaven in the Port of Rotterdam near the Hartelkanaal and the Nieuwe Maas estuary. The site includes the world's largest BDO plant, an independent inner harbor and a site-owned train and truck terminal. The terminal is linked to the Botlek and Maasvlakte plants by two 7-km pipelines. The site also includes a deep-water terminal in the Europoort area that was built in 1991. The terminal is located at the 7th Petroleumhaven near the Nieuwe Waterweg on the Calandkanaal, 16 km southwest of the city of Rotterdam and 3 km northwest of the Botlek site and is linked to the Botlek and Maasvlakte plants by pipelines. Site expansions include the addition of C4, MTBE and propylene glycol ether plants in 1980, a butanediol plant in 2002 and in 2015, a C4 capacity increase and the addition of steam boilers to provide the site's own steam for the production processes. Although Botlek and Maasvlakte sites each have their own operations and maintenance organization, both sites —referred to as BOMA- are headed by one management team.
